Ridgeway Views sits within the boundaries of one of London's oldest villages, surrounded by acres of greenbelt countryside. Mill Hill Village, with its pretty duck pond, a working community farm, 'Outstanding' schools and traditional inns, is a hidden treasure with fast links to central London and beyond by Tube, rail and road.

Reach London's West End in under 30 minutes via the Northern Line from Mill Hill East Underground, with swift rail connections to the City – as well as onward services to Europe

from St Pancras International – also on offer from Mill Hill Broadway just a short bus ride away.

By road, the M1 and A1 are only 5 minutes away, providing easy access into central London, Heathrow and Luton Airports and the university cities of Cambridge and Oxford.

From the daily commute to longer-distance travel, with such easy transport on your doorstep getting around couldn't be more convenient, allowing you to enjoy the best of rural and city life.









## Think city, live rural

Within easy reach of Ridgeway Views, you'll find open spaces, activities and amenities to cater to build a career in veterinary for country and city tastes alike. As well as on-site facilities, the local area has so much to offer – from parkland, shops and restaurants, to schools, fitness facilities and entertainment.

Enjoy the great outdoors Nature lovers and Sunday strollers are spoilt for choice in Mill Hill. Folly Brook flows for two miles across north London, giving runners, walkers and horse-riders a chance to escape city life. Mill Hill Park provides a family-friendly haven in which the children can let off steam. Hampstead Heath, famed for its open-air swimming, is a calming oasis popular with locals; it even houses a zoo. Meanwhile, Darlands Lake Nature Reserve is home to a wealth of wildlife, from wildfowl, mallards and moorhens to frogs, newts, goldfish, the occasional kingfisher and 12 species of dragonfly. This quiet, sheltered lake is surrounded by woodland that only adds to the sense of peaceful seclusion.

Keep the kids busy Located in Mill Hill Village, Belmont Farm is the only public farm of its size within the M25, offering a unique opportunity to meet a wide variety of different animals, from cows and rabbits, to goats and exotic lovebirds. As well as tractor rides and a café, there are

numerous volunteering opportunities for those looking science or animal husbandry. The farm is also opening a new private day nursery in autumn 2019. Taking riding lessons or booking the family onto a hack with the much-loved horses and ponies of the nearby London Equestrian Centre is yet another way to explore the beautiful greenbelt surrounding Ridgeway Views.

#### A first-class education

Ridgeway Views has a wide choice of primary and secondary schools nearby, all rated 'Good' or 'Outstanding' by Ofsted. Just a short walk away is Mill Hill School – a private co-educational independent day and boarding school for ages 13-18. Also in the area is the Queen Elizabeth's School, Barnet – a grammar school for boys currently ranked third in the UK league table of the top 100 schools.

What's more, with easy access to some of the world's leading universities – from the London School of Economics and Imperial College in central London, to Cambridge and Oxford – Ridgeway Views truly opens up a wealth of first-class educational opportunities.

Make the historic Adam & Eve pub your local and you'll enjoy locally sourced, modern British food and a traditional warm welcome. With a charming Victorian walled garden to the rear, this country pub promotes – home to the Saracens – is an itself as 'a destination for the discerning'. The Orange Tree in Totteridge also offers a sophisticated setting and seasonal menus; it's the perfect Golf Club features a picturesque place to entertain friends and relax with family.

The bustling high streets of neighbouring Mill Hill Broadway, Whetstone and High Barnet offer a wealth of boutique stores, artisan bakeries, speciality coffee shops events, there's so much to and exceptional restaurants.
